How to Search


Please note that there are six main things to Search. This write-up goes over each of those in detail starting on page 2. The following search topics are covered:

• Address

- Intersection
- Geographic Coordinates (Lat / Lon)

AIN/APN (Parcel Number)

• MDR Leased Parcel



Address Search

Enter in the site address as a number and street name, followed by the city name and/or ZIP Code, and click the **Search** button (magnifying glass icon) or hit enter. Be as complete and accurate as possible. As you start typing, you should get an 'auto complete' list below the search box. If there are multiple addresses that match what you typed, you can choose the correct one from the list:

Important Considerations:

- No comma separators are necessary and address entries are not case sensitive.
- Including directional characters (n, s, e, and w) is highly recommended (e.g., 320 w temple st).
- Including correct street suffixes is also highly recommended. For example, in unincorporated Florence-Firestone, there are streets such as "82nd St" and "82nd Pl". Likewise, the numbered streets in Antelope Valley typically have suffixes of either E or W; similar addressing schemes exist elsewhere throughout the County. A missing or incorrect street suffix can result in an erroneous result - either a wrong location or an error message.
- "Avenue" can be shortened to "Ave" in such addresses as "16921 E Avenue O, Lancaster CA 93561". In these cases up in the Antelope Valley, make sure to include street directions (either spelled out, or first initial - see screenshot to right).
- Addresses on a numbered street with a dash (mostly in the Antelope Valley) (-) must be entered <u>without</u> the dash; example "10606 E Avenue R8, Palmdale, California 93550". If entered with a dash, you will get erroneous results. (see screenshot below).

AIN/APN Parcel Searches


Enter in the AIN parcel number with or without dashes (5161005910 or 5161-005-910). Like the address search, the 'auto complete' list will populate as you type (see screenshot below):

Search is also possible for all parcels that start with the first 7 digits in AIN

Intersection Searches

Intersection searches require the names of no more than two intersecting streets, separated by "and" or "&", and followed by either the local city name or zip code. Entering two streets that lie closely parallel to each other will not return a result. Examples of valid intersection searches:



Geographic Coordinates (Latitude/Longitude)

The format is 'lat, long' and the search can handle the Decimal Degrees only in the following formats:

- 34.45305556, -118.07916667
- N 34.45305556, W 118.07916667
- N 34.45305556 N, 118.07916667 W

If you have anything in the following formats listed below, you will need to convert it to decimal degrees using this website:

Convert degrees, minutes, seconds (eg. 34° 27' 11" N, 118° 04' 45" W) Degrees and decimal minutes (e.g. N34 39.0491, W118 00.061)
Degrees, minutes, seconds (e.g. 34° 27' 11" N, 118° 04' 45" W)


Marina del Rey Leased Parcels

MDR leased parcels require the "MDR:" be put in front of the leased parcel number you are looking for.

- MDR:49R


Clear Search Results

Use the Burger icon (Panel Action Menu) in the search panel to access the search menu options, the last item on the menu is "Clear Search Results", which will clear all your search results in this panel (see screenshot below).



Remove specific search results from search results panel

Previous search results are added to your search results panel in case you need to go back to one of your previous searches, but if you need to clear a specific search item please click on it then click on the burger icon, then click "Remove from Results" (see screenshot below).



Return to search results

In case you accidently closed the search results panel, you can get back to it without redoing your search. Please click on the "I want to..." menu, then click on "Return to search results".
